STAND DOWN 2024

The North Florida Homeless and At-Risk Veterans Stand Down was held July 12 & 13 at the Al Lawson Multi-Purpose Center on the campus of Florida A&M University. The event was initially scheduled for May 17 & 18, but had to be postponed due to the aftermath of the tornadoes that hit Tallahassee on May 10. Fortunately, all parties involved made the necessary adjustments to hold a successful event providing services to our local veterans.

The Opening Ceremony was moderated by Doug Apple, General Manager of WAVE 94 (94.1 WAKU) Radio.
